<p><u>WP1-2 November 2012.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The actual summer school will take place from Monday June 24 until Friday July 5, 2013. Please check lecturers' and students' availability for this period and inform me asap about any conflict or inconvenience versus your University timetable. Changes should be limited. If you want to stay privately (longer) in Greece, you can arrive earlier and/or leave later. If not, students' arrival is on Sunday 23th June and departure on Saturday 6th July, while lecturers' stay depends upon the total duration in days per each partner. <p><u>WP1-3 November 2012.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Define the participating lecturers from your University. Before doing that, please confirm the max no. of incoming teachers in the excel file: LiDe stud-teachers. Define their topics according to your previous statement (see word file LiDe partner's topic). Each topic corresponds to a two-hour lecture (90-100min). The majority of the lectures will be scheduled within the morning sessions (TM) while afternoon sessions (TA) will be mainly reserved to students' projects. Lecturers can also participate in students' project work during afternoon sessions. Each partner is assigned to participate to limited number of topics TM and/or TA.
